Cornerstone Craftsman is an Alexandria City-based organization providing at-risk youth (aged 12-17) with skilled trades and mentoring training. Our unique pre-apprenticeship program allows young men and women to build viable careers, earn a livable wage, and pursue economic self-sufficiency. By offering vocational career pathways, we are opening doors to alternative education routes with the skills and resources needed for success. Cornerstone Craftsman was formed in August 2023 and has applied for IRS 501(c)(3) status.

We seek a Program Instructor to serve as an important member of our pre-apprentice program team. You will work closely with another instructor, the founder, and the executive director, Roberto Gomez.

Responsibilities:

- Instruct 12- to 17-year-old at-risk youth in the skilled trades in three to six-hour morning shifts two Saturdays a month. Training module outlines, tools, and materials will be provided.
- Prepare the training area, clean up the training area, and keep an accurate inventory of all tools and materials.
- Submit attendance, individual participant progress reports, and material needs to the supervisor.
- Manage all project elements in partnership with another instructor.
- Utilize a variety of hand and power tools
- Follow all local, state, and federal health and safety standards
- Commit to continually improving your skills through on-the-job training
- Carry out other administrative and operations tasks as assigned.

- Experience working with at-risk youth or vulnerable populations.
- High level of patience, compassion, and understanding as an instructor or teacher.
- Skilled in handling conflict and problem-solving.

- Ability to use a wide variety of tools
